
Rowan University is a Carnegie classified national doctoral research institution dedicated to excellence in undergraduate education. Founded in 1923, Rowan University has evolved from a teacher preparation school to a comprehensive research university that's ranked by U.S. News & World Report among the best national public research universities in the nation. The historic \$100 million Rowan gift in 1992 put the institution on the fast track, fostered the creation of the College of Engineering and enabled ambitious growth. Nearly 96 percent of Rowan students are New Jersey residents. In all, the student body hails from 42 states and 32 countries.
